
- Goal of newborn screening and what lowa's NBS program does to meet that goal

The laws in Iowa regarding newborn screening



- How important submitter role is in the system
 - Need to make sure both collection and transit processes complement each other and are helping to reach the best outcome for each baby.
 - Multiple people and departments involved and important to know how each piece fits in the puzzle
- Quality of sample and filling out the form is part of timeliness




Communication tool





CollN reports emailed

- Currently only going to birthing facilities

 - Quality control
 - Turnaround statistics
 - Facility summary
- Newborn screening staff to request custom data.









