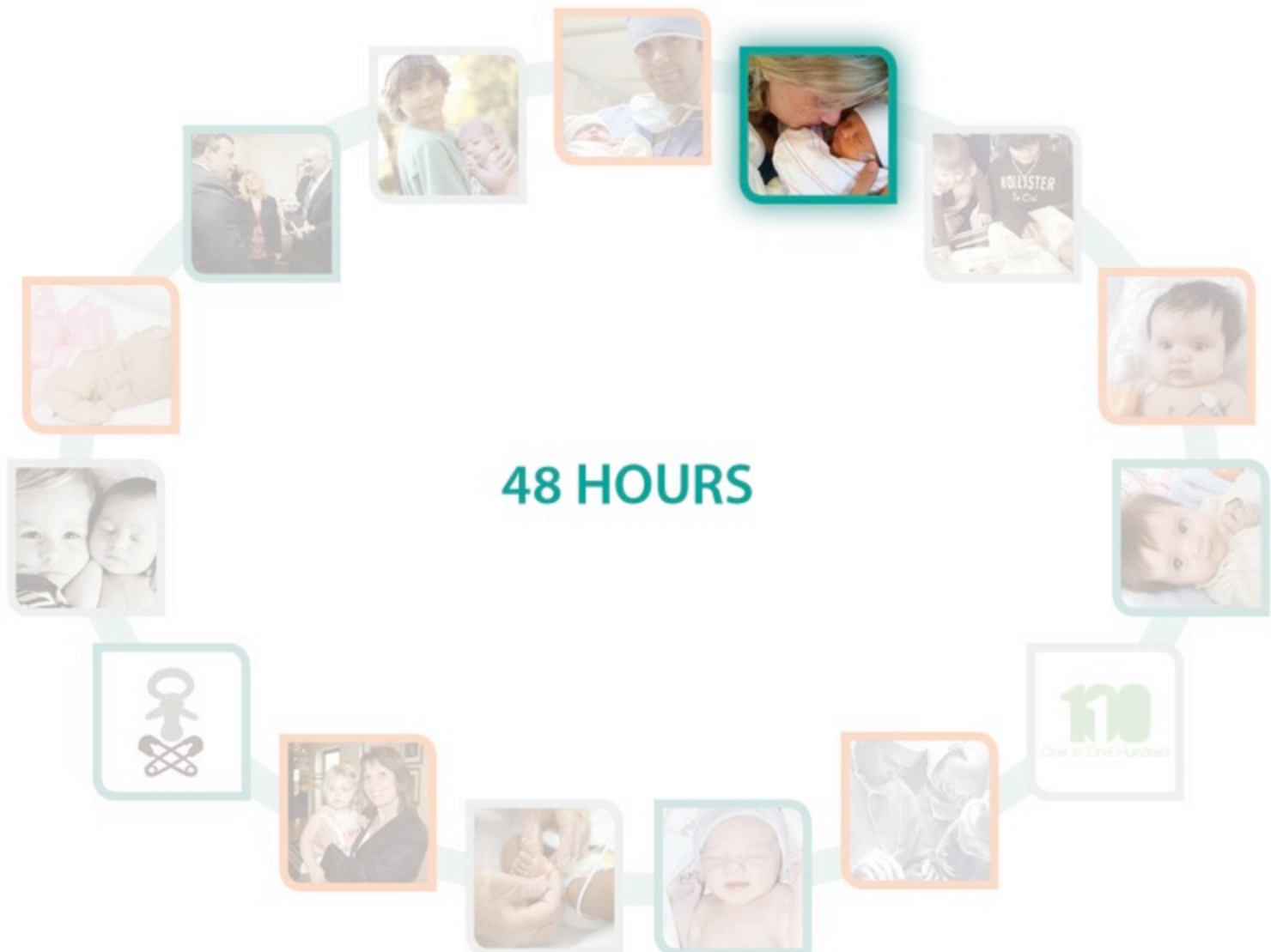

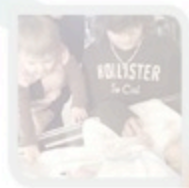

Fewer than 50% of CCHD are diagnosed prenatally, number drops based on geographic / demographic disparity

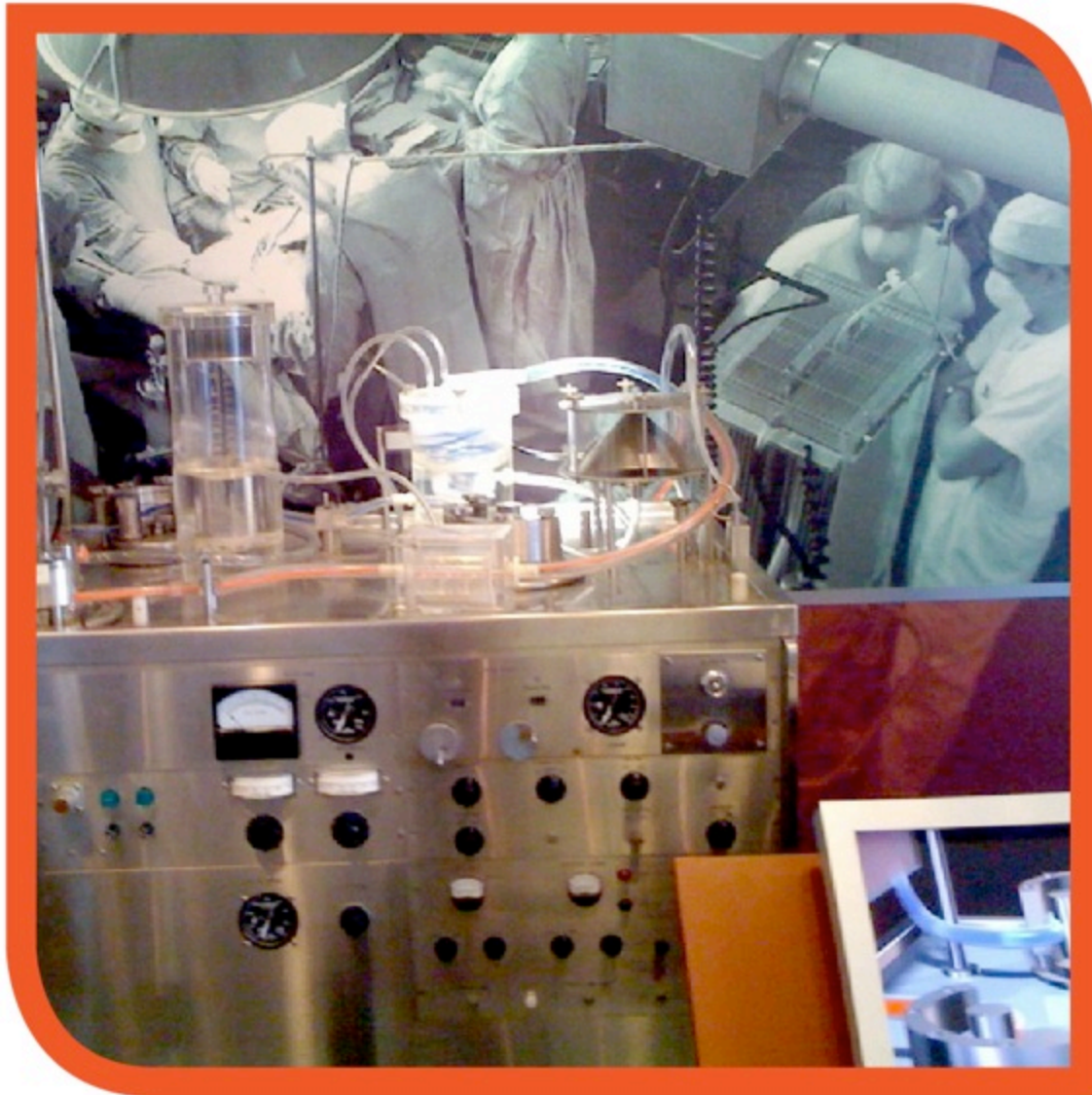
