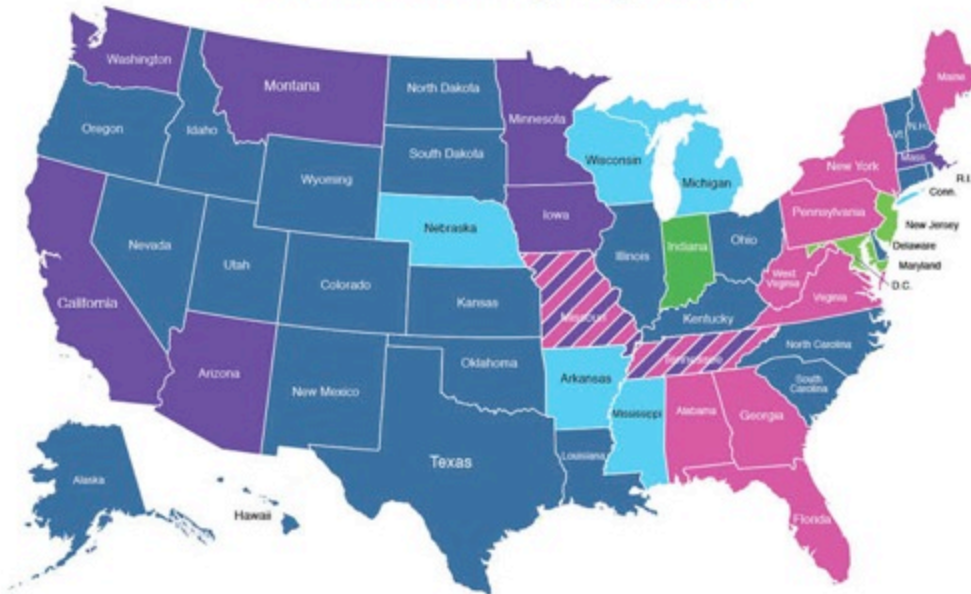

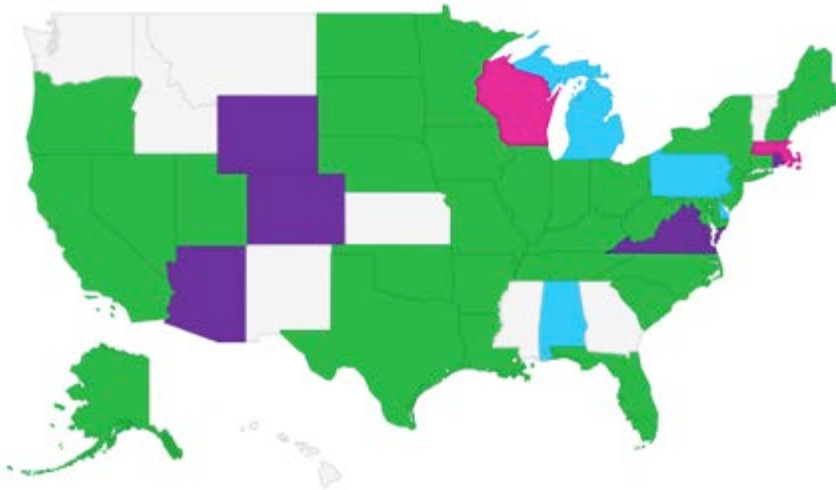

Progress

33 states have passed legislation or statutes

32.5% of newborns in the United States are currently being screened for CHD using pulse oximetry. [1]

Number expected to increase to almost 80% by end of 2014. [2]

Arabian Gulf, Abu Dhabi – Fully implemented

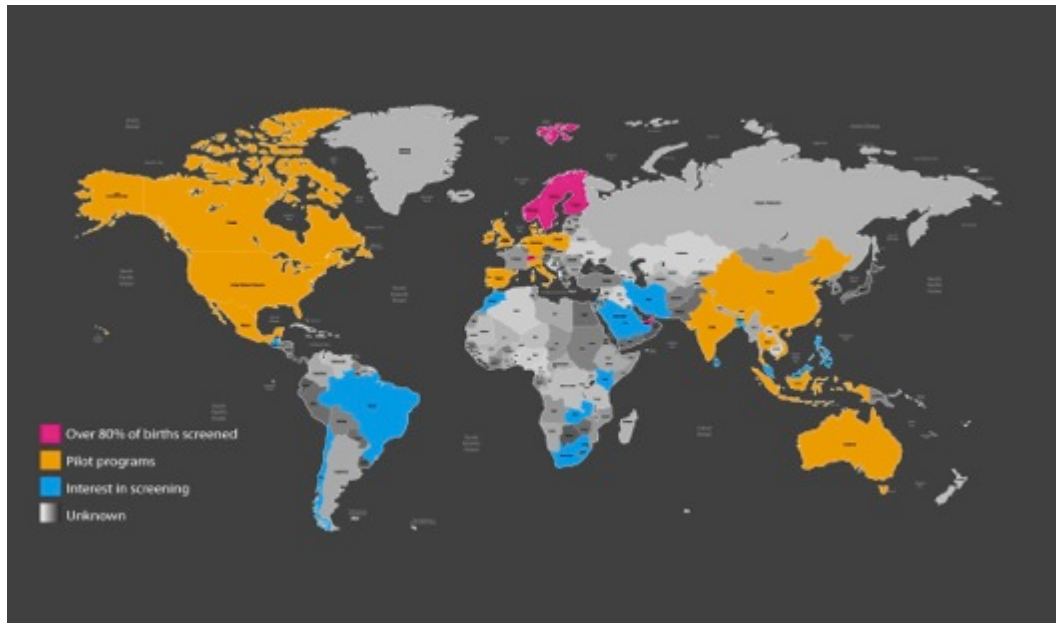
Europe, Nordic countries, Switzerland – major implementation progress

Ireland – formal recommendations made

United Kingdom – 20% of all maternity units screening

Germany, the Netherlands – Pilots underway
