To achieve the highest quality for newborn screening systems by providing relevant, accurate tools and resources and to facilitate collaboration between state programs and other newborn screening partners.

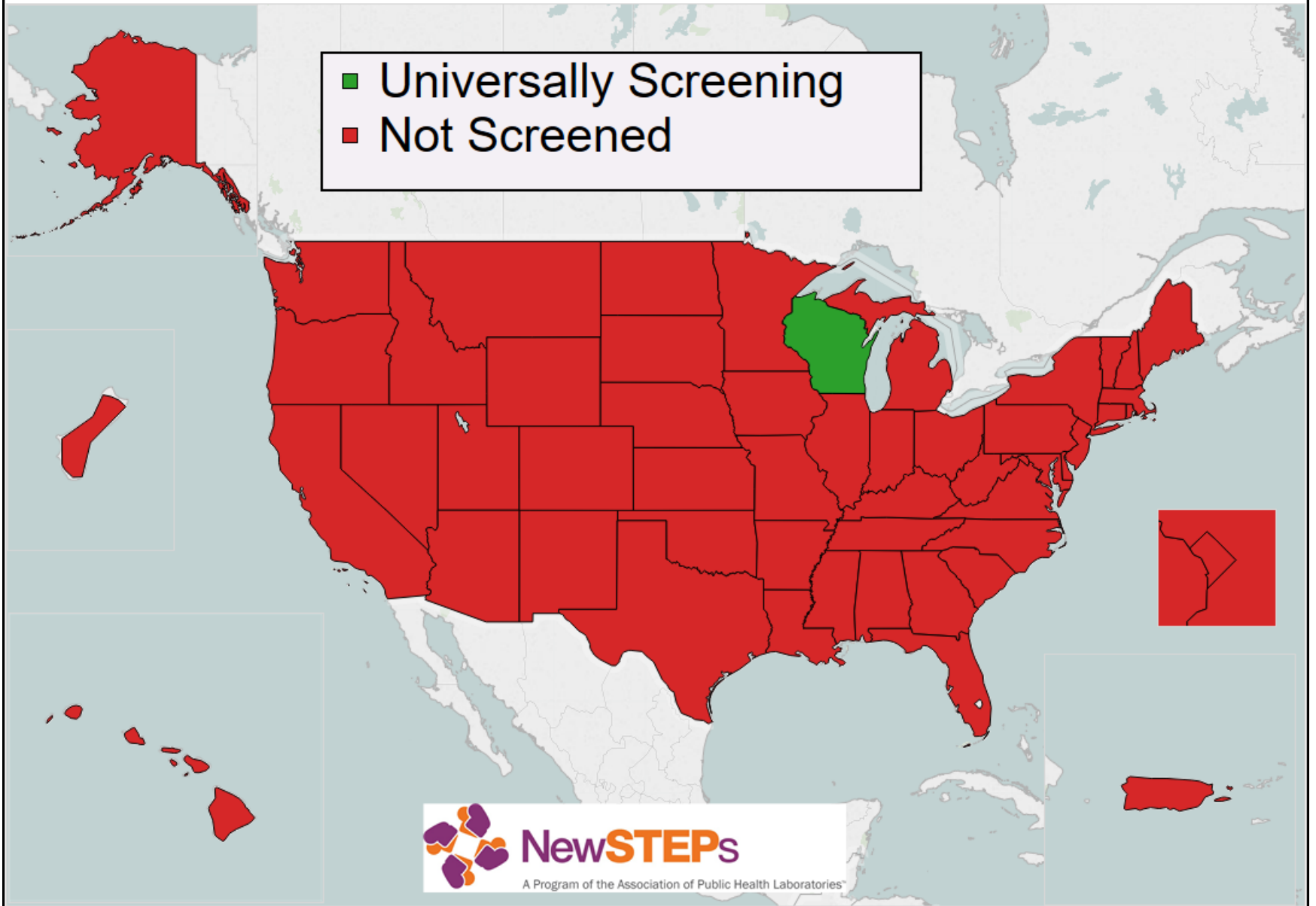

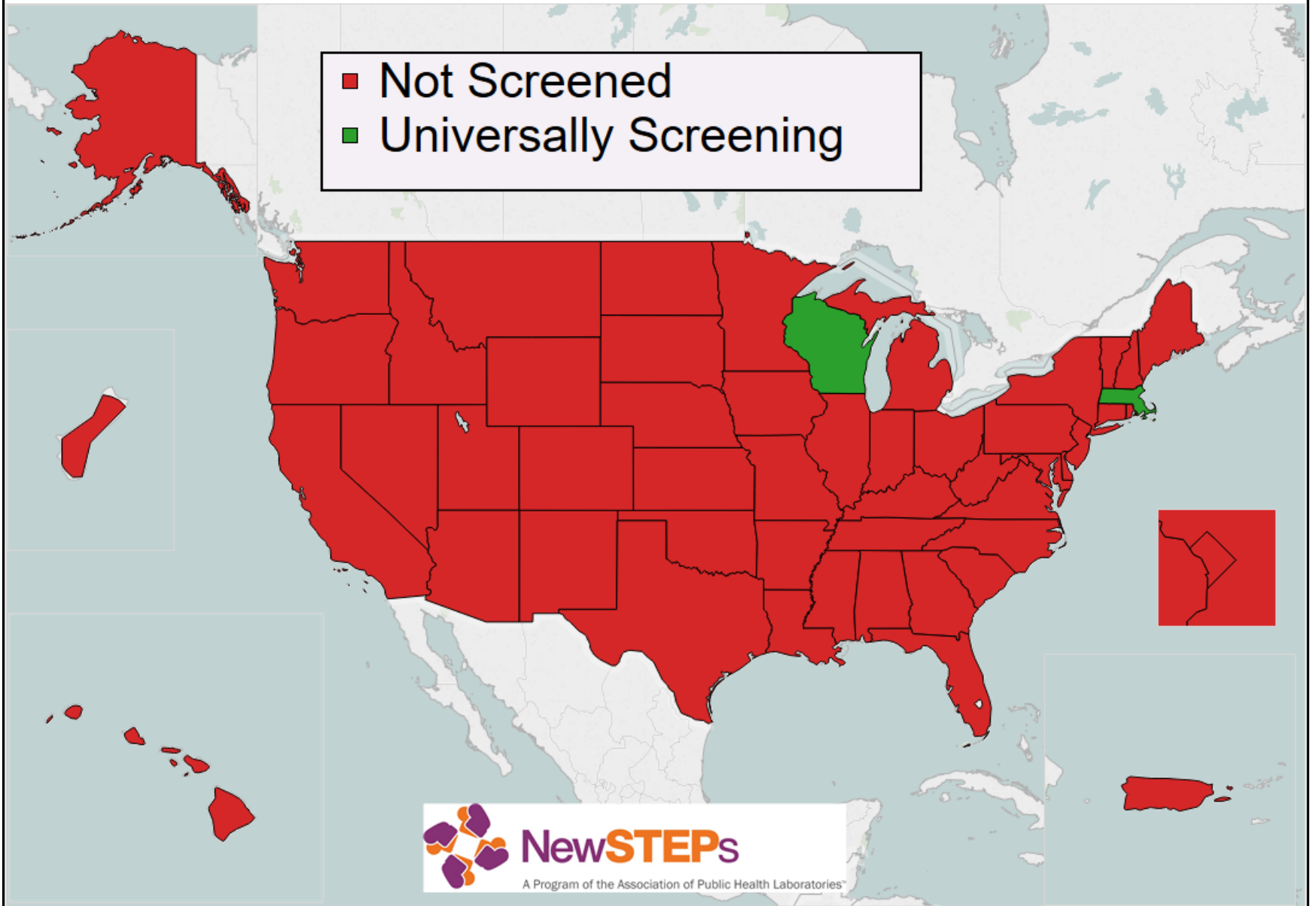
SCID Newborn Screening Status 2008

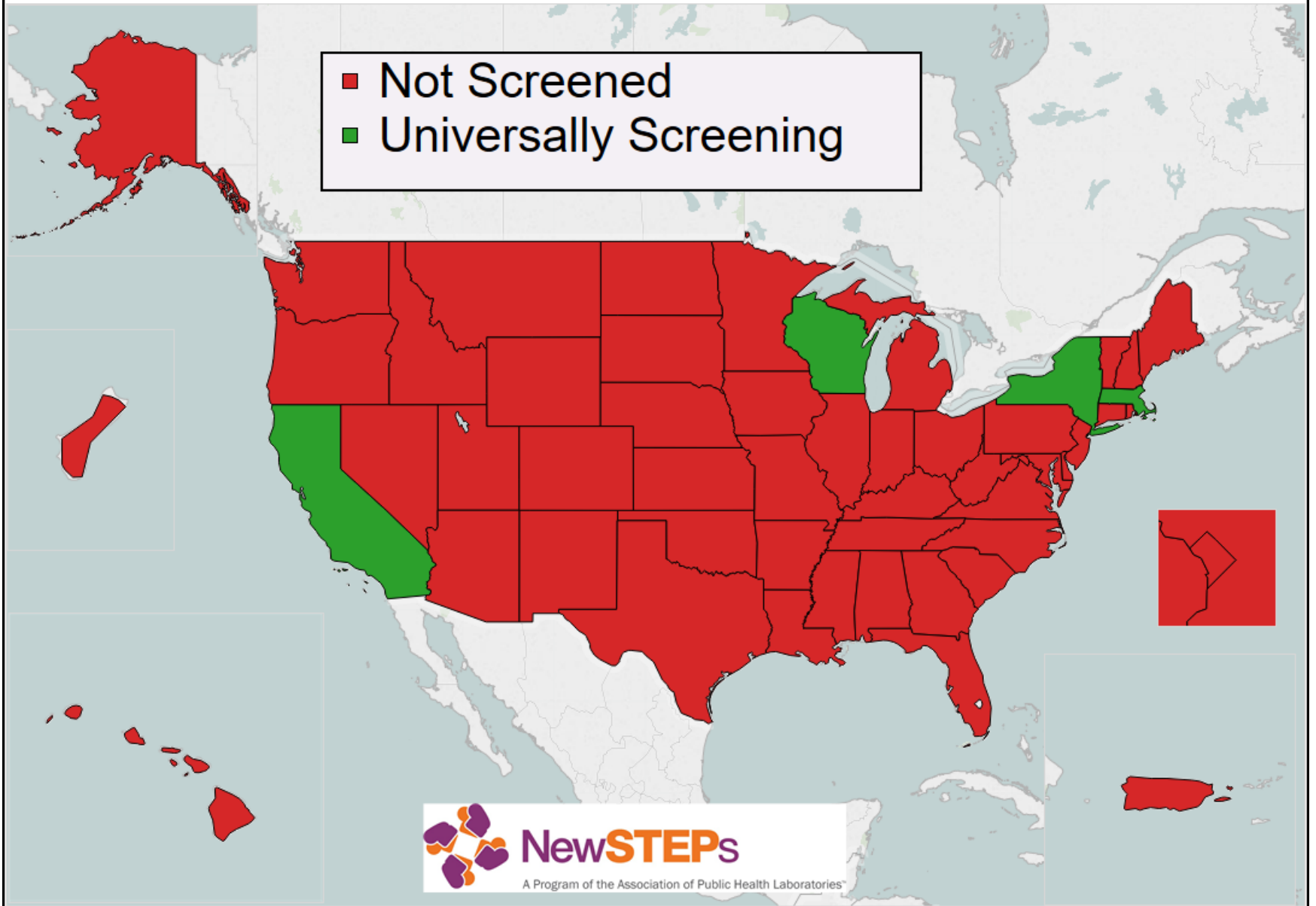
SCID Newborn Screening Status 2009

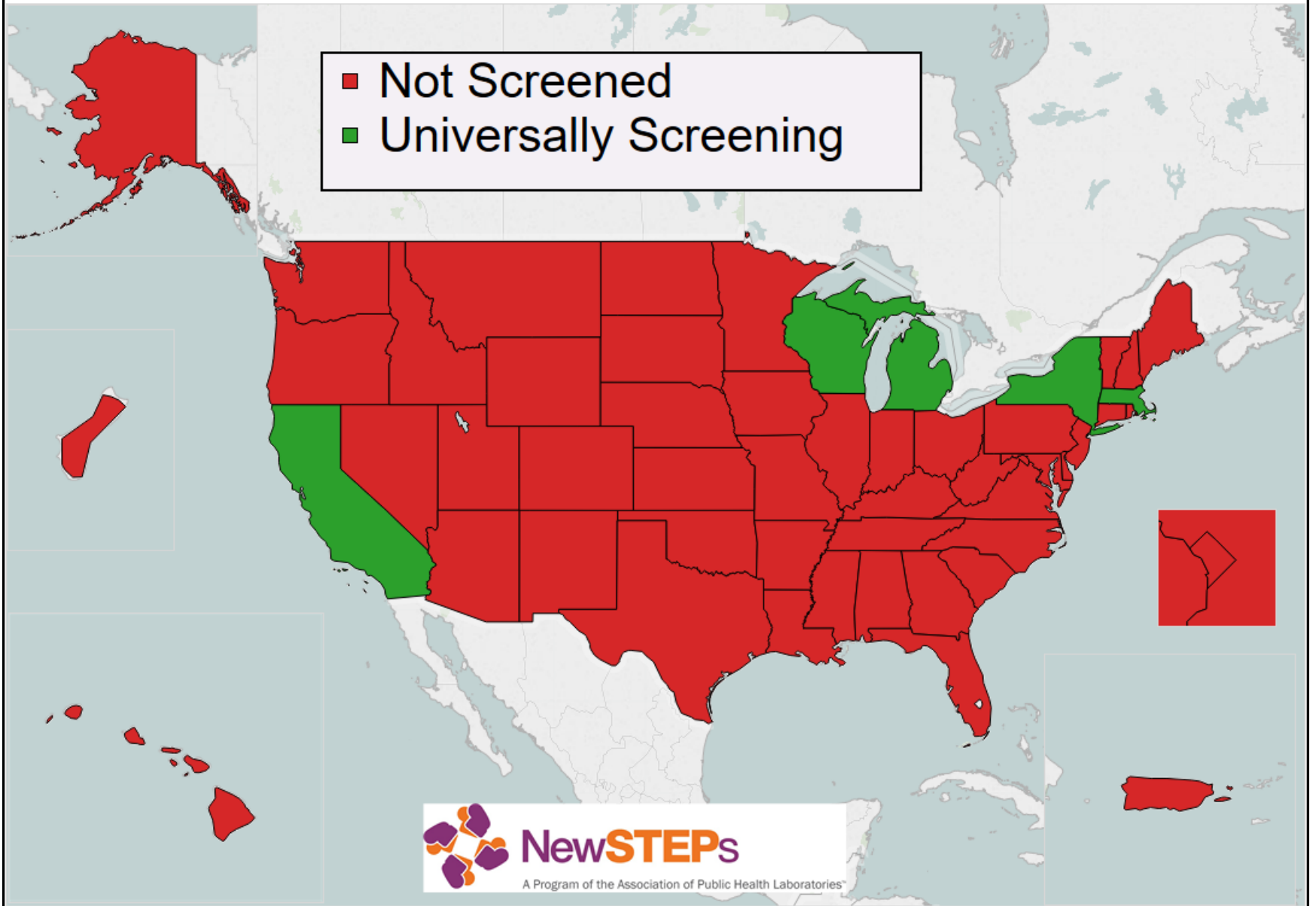
SCID Newborn Screening Status 2010

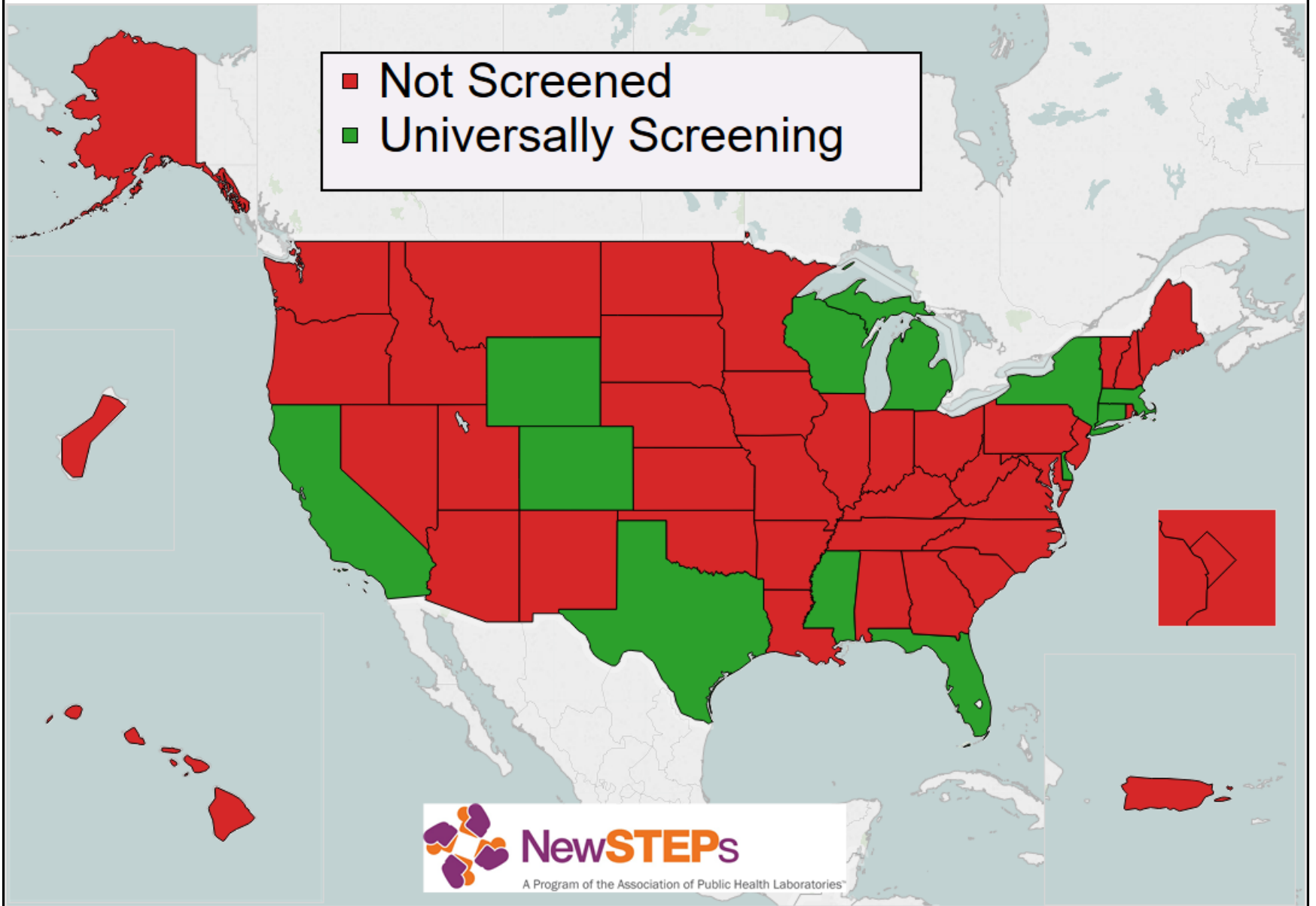
SCID Newborn Screening Status 2011

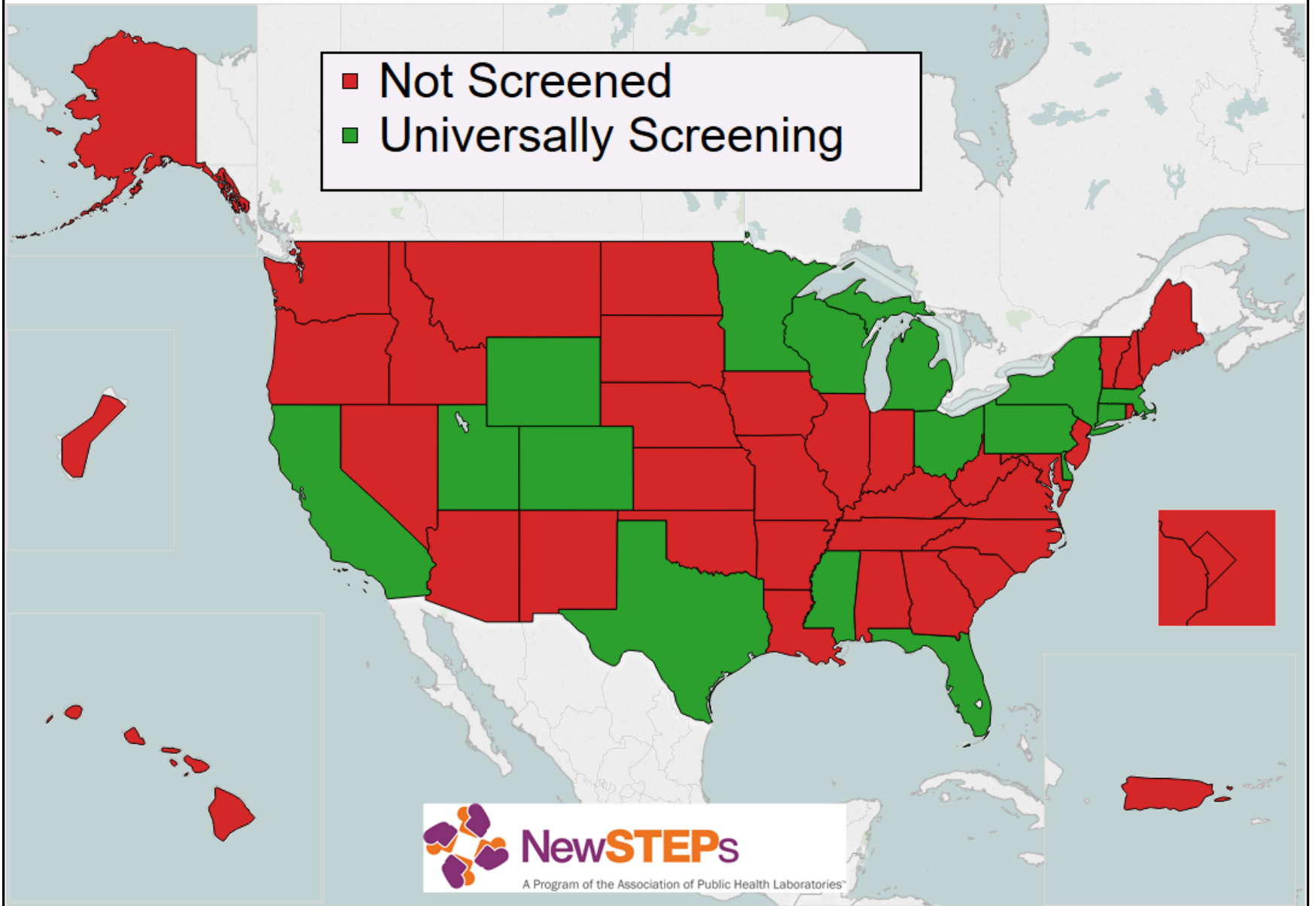
SCID Newborn Screening Status 2012

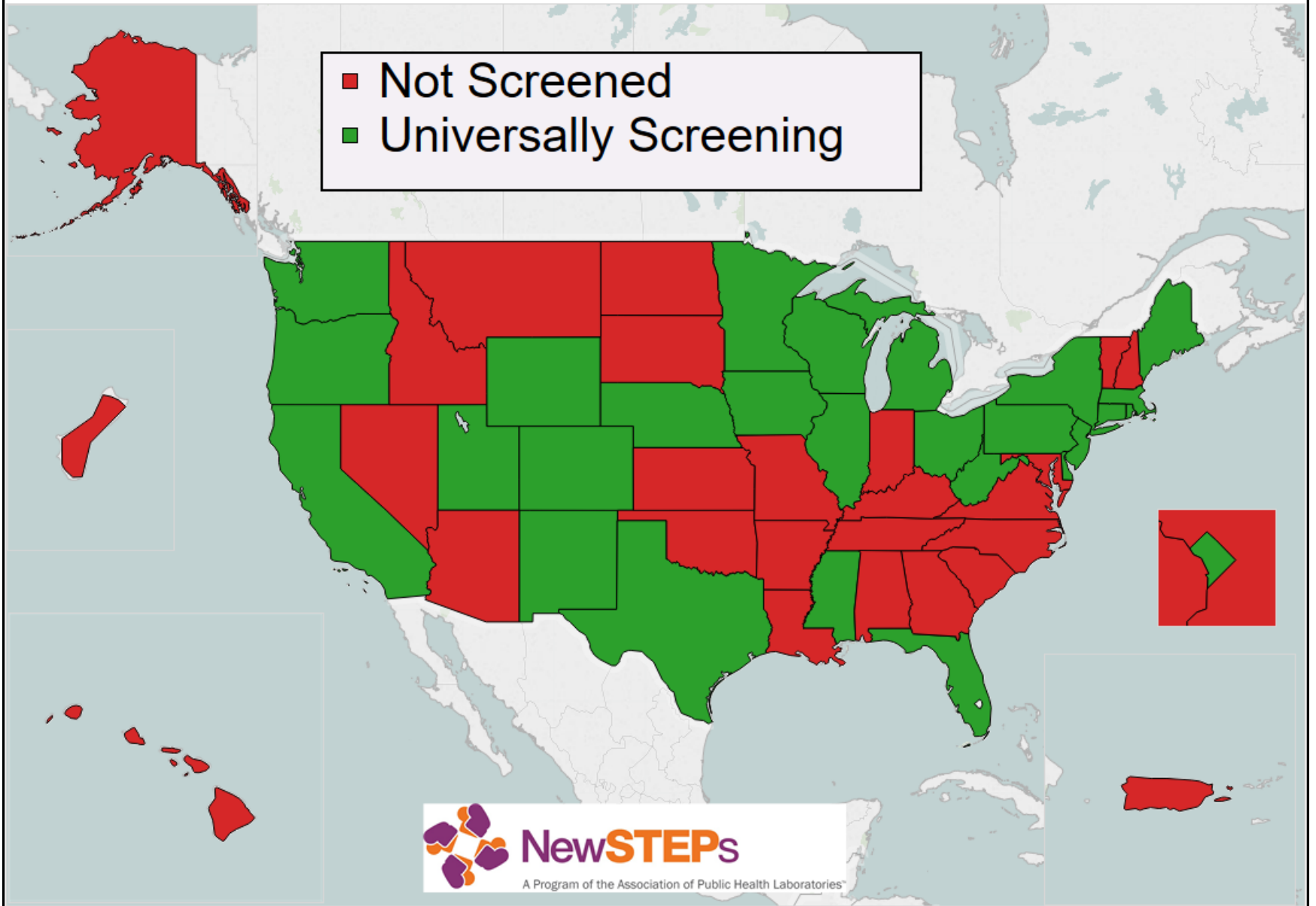
SCID Newborn Screening Status 2013

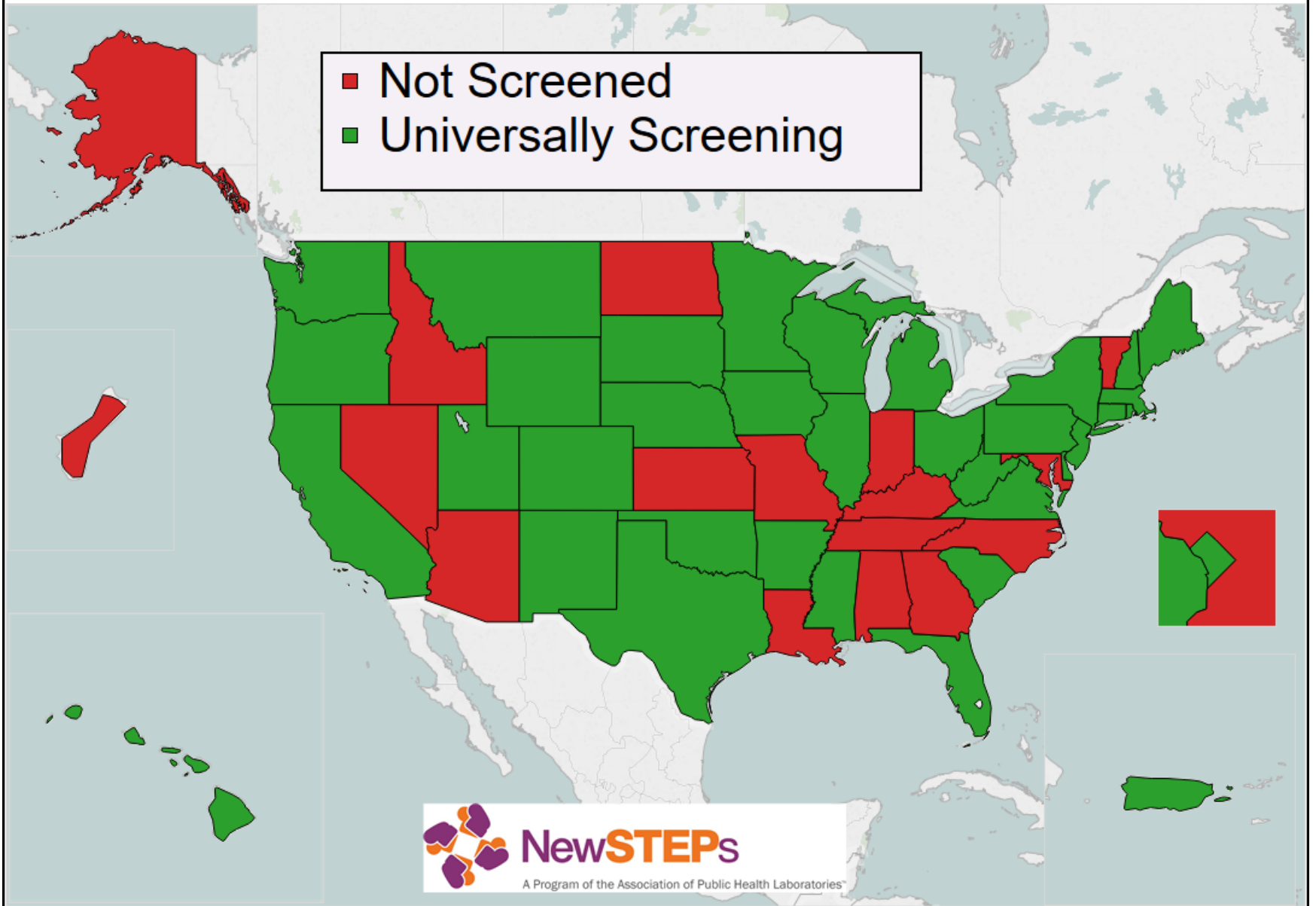
SCID Newborn Screening Status 2014

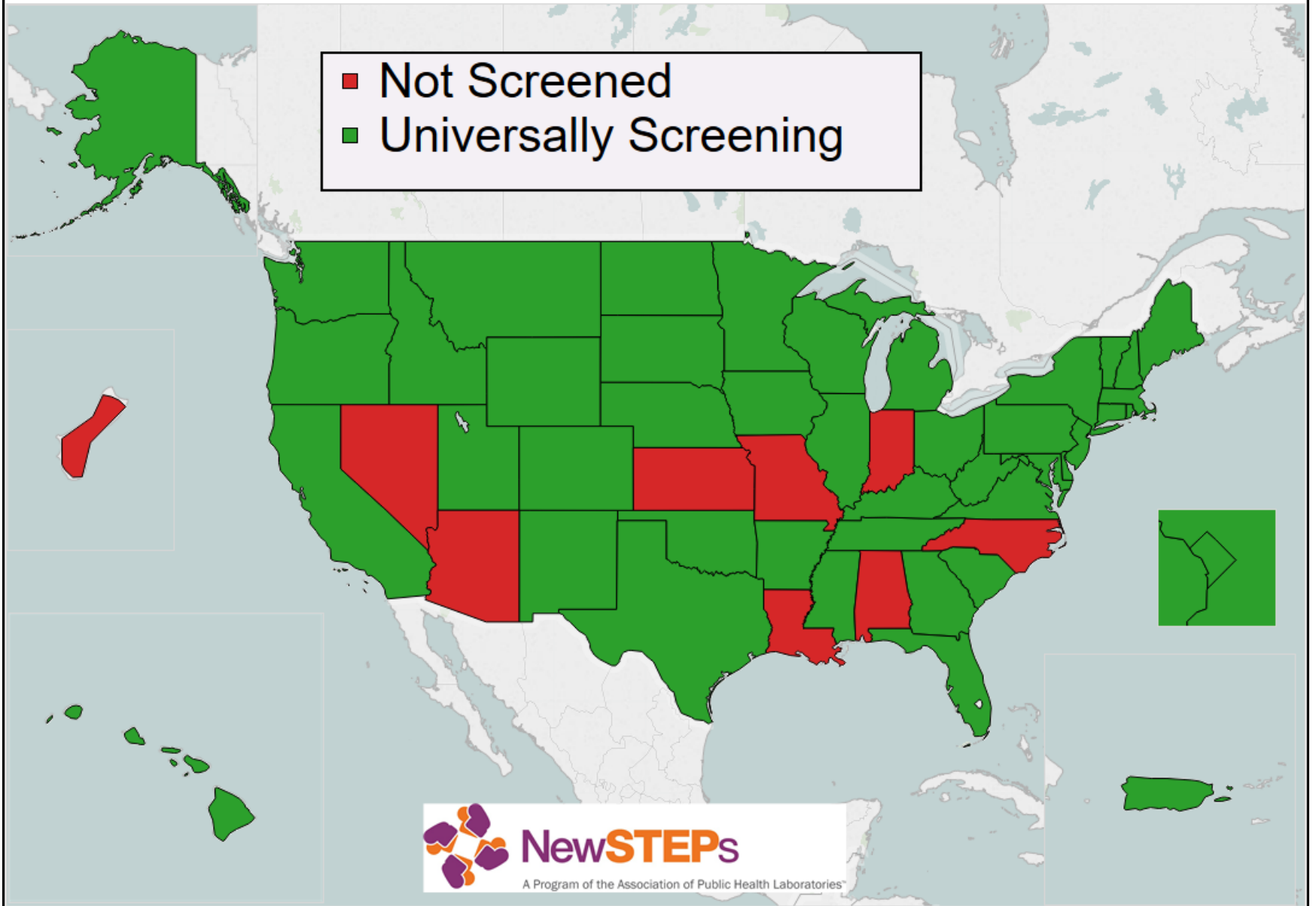

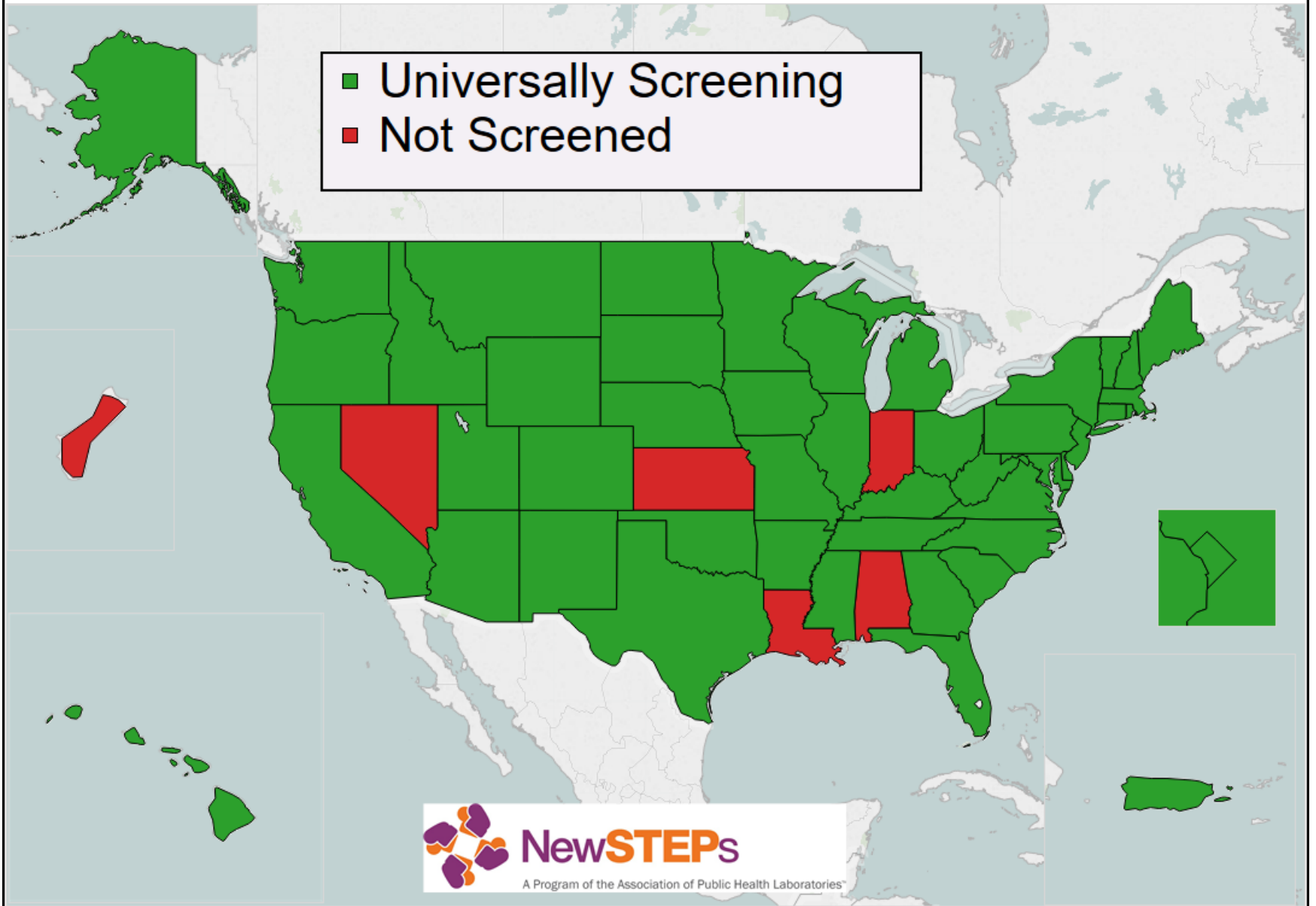
SCID Newborn Screening Status 2016
